The Passenger Rail Agency of South Africa, parent company to Metrorail, is currently offering ongoing support to the families of the students involved in the tragic level crossing accident in Cape Town. PRASA Group CEO, Mr. Lucky Montana, has sent senior representatives from PRASA to visit the affected families, and children currently in hospital and to extend a hand of comfort and support.

Senior members from PRASA and its division Metrorail, visited the scene of the accident yesterday, as well as the children at Tygerberg and Red Cross Children's Hospitals and the affected families.

"PRASA will provide emotional and whatever material support it can provide to the affected families during this time of great loss and sadness. The tragedy has affected all of us deeply. Our staff who witnessed the tragedy are currently undergoing trauma counseling" said Mr Montana.
