Boulders Penguin Colony, a pay-for-entry beach in Table Mountain National Park, is sheltered by boulders and has a boardwalk to Foxy Beach, one of the world's only land-based penguin colonies. It's great fun for children and adults too!

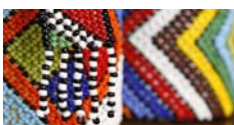
